

Joyce Sieve watercolor supply list:

Paints: I use Steven Quiller watercolors. I will have paint for class for a small palette fee.

If you want to buy paints Winsor & Newton watercolors will work but be sure to get professional grade. I do suggest you wait until after the first class. I will explain why at the class.

The colors that I will use are: New Gamboge, Cadmium Red, Raw Sienna, Ultramarine blue, Burnt Umber, Alizarin Crimson, & Quinacadmone red

Brushes: I use a round brush with a good point about a size 8 or 10.

You may also want a liner brush (not needed right away)

You must have a Louise Jackson #170-S It is a soft blender & I will have them the first class.

Supplies: Roll of Charmin toilet tissue
Palette Knife with a thin blade & flexible tip
Tracing paper
Transfer paper for watercolor (I will share)
2 - Water basins
Notebook or sketchbook for notes
Pen & pencil, you might want a highlighter also
Stylus
See thru - ruler 12" or 18"
